## BY THE PRIME MINISTER OF THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL JANEZ JANŠA AT THE CEREMONY TO CELEBRATE THE ADOPTION OF THE EURO IN THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS

Nicosia, 18 January 2008

Mr President, Mr President of the European Commission, Mr President of the European Central Bank, Madam Vice-President of the European Parliament, Ladies and Gentlemen, Excellencies,

I am delighted and proud to be with you today. It is my honour to share in the pride and energy that you feel now at this historic moment.
