Young Bled Strategic Forum Bled, 1. september 2013

Dear young entrepreneurs, visionaries, and future leaders, Distinguished guests, Ladies and gentlemen,

Let me try to add some of key challenges, which should in my opinion definitely find place on this to do list. Key words in no particular order: cooperation between generations, education, digital revolution, innovation, ethics, ambition and proactivity.

Cooperation between generations can be a catalyst of change and education is the key to this change – each generation has something to offer, let it be entrepreneurship experience, knowledge, digital skills, know-how. Once this is shared among generations, your and our challenges can be tackled.

Digital revolution provides information gathering on all possible levels and sectors, but, and this is important, it must include ethics and ethical behaviour.

Ambition is an important element of success, but equally important are innovation and ideas. It is crucial for young people to take risks, overcome personal reservations and be ambitious about their ideas and dreams.

Young people today should not only work hard, but also be proactive in seeing and providing possibilities.

Solving youth unemployment is one of the key priorities of the Slovenian Government. We realize our part in improving your situation, and we are working hard to provide you with more job opportunities, better education and with incentives to become financially independent.

I promise you that I will examine the outcome of this conference and will take my part in addressing the need of young generation with full responsibility.
